Tax Extensions

If you need an extension of time to file your 2022 tax return, you must file a Form 4868 with the IRS by April 18, 2023. This form can be mailed or filed electronically on IRS.gov.

Be aware, this is an extension of time to file, not an extension of time to pay. If a balance is due on your tax return, you will need to make a payment by April 18, 2023, to avoid any additional late penalties. Unless otherwise agreed upon, you are responsible for calculating the tax owed and sending in your payment, if needed. Payments can be made online, or by check if accompanied by a Form 4868 that includes your personal information. If you think you might need to make an extension payment, you can use the amount due on your 2021 tax return as your base and adjust, if necessary, due to your 2022 activity. We always suggest you add 10% above your estimate to include a “cushion” and if applicable, include your 1st quarter 2023 estimated tax payment with your extension payment.
